5. Programme

The ITF International Instructors Course will include the following programme and/or qualifications:

- 1. patterns from Chon-Ji up to Tong-Il
- 2. step sparring
- 3. self defence
- 4. ITF International Instructor Qualification (4th degree and up)
- 5. grading up to 8th degree (permission from NGB and ITF is needed)

Participants wishing to test for degree promotion must:

- send the application form through the National/Allied Association at least one (3) month before the promotion date to the ITF Administrative HQ.
- bring 5 wooden boards measured 30x30x2 cm (only from 1st to 6th degree).
- pay their grading fee in cash prior to the grading.
- test for degree promotion will be at the last day of the course and the result shall given directly after the promotion.
- no spectators are allowed during the degree promotion.
- the candidate might be accompanied by his instructor.
