This form is used to file an appeal with the International Taekwon-Do Federation (ITF) after the ITF has given notice of its decision regarding a complaint of unethical behaviour or improper conduct about a national member of the ITF (be it a National Association or Allied Association) or an individual who is a member of the ITF through a National Association or Allied Association.

An appeal may be filed by a defendant or a complainant. In both instances, the appeal must be sent **to the President of the ITF within 20 days** of the Appellant being notified of the ITF's decision.
