Addis Ababa or Addis Abeba (the spelling used by the official Ethiopian Mapping Authority), (Amharic: มหากลา Addis Abäba IPA: [adˈdisˈabəba] (ฟ listen), "new flower"; Oromo: Finfinne, [3][4][fɪnˈfɪn.nɛ] "Natural Spring(s)"), is the capital city of Ethiopia. Founded in 1886, it is the

largest city in Ethiopia, with a population of around 6.5 million

population census with annual growth rate of 3.8%. This number has been increased from the originally published 2,738,248 figure and appears to be still largely underestimated.

As a <u>chartered city</u> Addis Ababa has the status of both a city and a <u>state</u>. It is where the <u>African Union</u> is and its predecessor the <u>OAU</u> was based. It also hosts the headquarters of the <u>United Nations Economic Commission for Africa (ECA)</u> and numerous other continental and international organizations. Addis Ababa is therefore often referred to as "the political capital of Africa" due to its historical, diplomatic and political significance for the continent. [6]


The city is populated by people from different regions of Ethiopia – the country has as many as 80 nationalities speaking 80 languages and belonging to a wide variety of religious communities.

Note: - Due to the current COVID19 pandemic all competitors must use their own equipment.


Weigh In


The Weigh In shall take place on Friday April 8th 2022 at 14:00, according to the official weigh in scheduled (to be published in a timeframe closer to the event). The weigh-in will take place in the competition hall.

All competitors must be present for the weight check independent from competing in sparing or not. At this moment the identity of all competitors will be validated and confirmed.
