- Groin guard (worn inside the dobok trousers).

- Group 8 Female Junior 15-17 years old
- Group 9 Male Senior 18 years old and above
- Group 10 Female Senior 18 years and above

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- Each Team consists of 5 competitors.
- Teams are divided into A class blue, red, and black belts
- Teams are divided into B class yellow to green belts

Duration of round(s)

- 1 round x 2 minutes
- There must be at least two (2) teams in the division.
- In case of only one (1) team, they will be inserted in another category.

 and participation to the event.
- There must be at least two (2) competitors in any division and/or category.

- Each bout consists of **one** pattern only.
