

Main Topics of the Seminar:

First Session: Biomechanics and Generation of Power in Taekwon-Do **Second Session:** Injury prevention during our daily Training routine

Lecturer:

Master Mariusz Steckiewicz is an 8th degree black belt and professional ACE (American Council on Exercise) Certified Personal Trainer and sports coach, who's currently based in Ho Chi Minh City, Vietnam. Master Steckiewicz has been into sports since his early teenage years, along with his great passion for Taekwon-Do. He has over 35 years of training and coaching experience, including a successful competitive career with 3 gold medals from the ITF Taekwon-Do European Championships (1996, 1997, 1999) and 6 gold medals from the Polish Championships. More notably, he has also coached Finland and Vietnam's national teams. Under his guidance, Finland rose from the far-middle of the list in the general classification to 5th in the World and 2nd in all of Europe. His Finnish and Vietnamese athletes have won 8 Gold medals from World Championships and dozens from the European and Asian Championships.



Brief Content:

The seminar will be divided in two sessions according to the main topics mentioned above, and it will cover techniques from patterns and some of the more problematic elements while we practice those techniques. Master Mariuz will also introduce exercises and drills to help strengthen our hand and kicking techniques for patterns, power breaking, and sparring, followed by a very important session on injury prevention during training.
