

WORLD RECORD EVENT

IN TWIMYO NOPI AP CHA BUSIGI





At the initiative of Cosmin Oprescu - Board Member, with the approval of the TUI-Committee and the entire Board, we launched the project to set the WORLD RECORD in the TWIMYO NOPI AP CHA BUSIGI technique.

This world record competition is held for both men and women.

This World Record Event is independent, and it is not a category of the World Championship.

Nevertheless, the registration in Sportdata via ITF online will take place in the registration for the ITF Taekwon-Do World Championships 2025.

The World Record Event will hold in two parts.

- Part 1 – Qualification
- Part 2 – World Record Event

Part 1 – Qualification: The qualification is one valid attempt with a height of

- 2.40 m for women
- 2.70 m for men

An attempt is valid if the board engages at least at the 45° or more angle.

The qualification will be scheduled after the corresponding individual special technique event.

Part 2 – World Record Event: The World Record event starts with a height of

- 2.45 m for women
- 2.75 m for men

The World Record Event will be scheduled during the gala of the ITF Taekwon-Do World Championships 2025.

Each qualified participant has one attempt. In the event of a valid attempt, he/she will be given a new attempt for the next height and so on.

In the event of an invalid attempt, he/she is eliminated.

After each round, the height is increased by 5 cm. If nobody manages a valid attempt, the height is reduced by 4 cm.

From now on, the height is increased by 1 cm for each round.

The ring council responsible for special technic is to carry out the assessments.

The winners will be publicly announced across all social media channels, and we will strive to provide a prize for the achievement.
